CHRISTMAS LETTER FROM GOD
REV. JUNG UNG MOON

The reason we have life is because God created the whole world and everything in it. We cannot live even a few moments without the air which God made.

At Christmas, we give presents to each other but how are we able to do this? We need to remember that we can only give from what we have received. As Christians, we are able to give only what we have received from God. "God blessed them, and God said to them, Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth and subdue it; and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the air and over every living thing that moves upon the earth." (Genesis 1:28 NRSV)




All that we have is from God, so we are able to share what we have with God's love. The Apostle Paul called it a letter of Christ. "You yourselves are our letter, written on our hearts, to be known and read by all, and you show that you are a letter of Christ, prepared by us, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but tablets of human hearts." (2 Corinthians 3:2-3 NRSV) We are letters of Jesus for each other. They are not written by ink but by prayer. God always listens to our prayers, so we are letters of Jesus for each other in prayer.

This is a spiritual connection that we have in God. “Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And all of us, with unveiled faces, seeing the glory of the Lord as though reflected in a mirror, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another; for this comes from the Lord, the Spirit.” (2 Corinthians 3:17-18 NRSV) When we love each other, God gives His grace to us, and He becomes a blessed letter. His name is Jesus Christ, our Savior. “But the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid; for see—I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: to you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord.” (Luke 2:10-11)

We are all sinners, so we need to die because of our sin, but Jesus died on the cross for us. Jesus had no sin, but He paid the payment for our sins by His cross, and He was resurrected and became the Savior for us who believe in His name. When we pray in the name of Jesus, God listens to our prayer and answers us. Jesus made us His letters for people who do not know Him and also so that we can encourage our brothers and sisters in Jesus. I hope each of us from the Bayside UMC family becomes letters of Jesus.

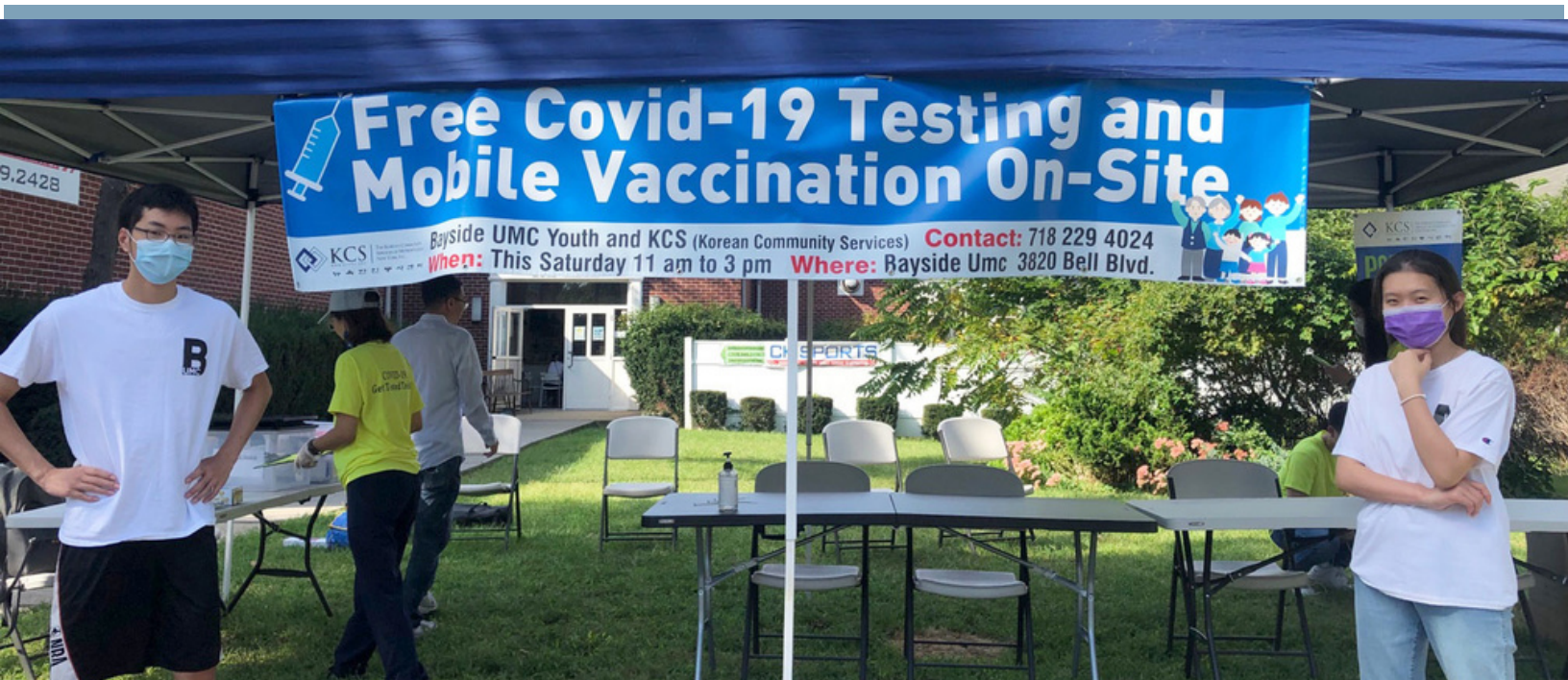
