Spiritual Decision

Life is a series of decisions. We can make one decision and it can change our lives but then the next one can cause our lives to move in a completely different direction. We need to be careful with the important decisions.

God has greatly blessed us by giving us the power to choose. We often make mistakes. If we look closely at our choices, we more often make the wrong decisions than the right ones. How do we know? We know we have made a wrong decision when we experience regret. Regret is the mind's reaction to the wrong decision. So how can we make a decision without having regrets? Unfortunately, this is impossible because we don't know the future. We will always make mistakes and we will often have regrets.

There is only one way to make decisions without regrets. The only way is by relying on the perfect God. This is what we call a faithful decision. The faithful decision is a decision made by relying on the Word, and this happens through prayer. Our problem is that we make decisions based on our greed. Greed begets sin, and sin begets death. So, those who have greed will eventually lose their life because of that greed. This does not mean that we simply lose our physical life, but we lose our spiritual life. God said, "The human mind plans the way, but the Lord directs the steps."

(Proverbs 16:9)

God has blessed BUMC's Sunday School with the most extraordinary children, now known as Living Through The Bible Kids. What a joyful, loving, kind, inquisitive, smart and creative group they are! We begin our time in prayer. We thank God for our church, our families, and our time together. We ask God, in Jesus name, to be present and pleased with all that we do.

One day, several students came in especially early and I decided to put on some kids' worship songs while setting up. After a few minutes, one of the younger children came up to me and said, "You forgot to open in prayer!" I smiled and said, "I didn't forget, we haven't started yet!"

Even young children can learn how important it is to have a relationship with God through prayer. I often ask them to try to remember to think of God before anything else in the morning. When they first open their eyes, before they even get out of bed, I ask them to say at least a simple prayer of, "Thank you, God!" This is to help them think about how we can do nothing without God. That very first breath of the day, which is an awesome gift from God, allows them to do all the things they want to do. The children are encouraged to talk to God throughout the day when they feel upset, worried, or even just to say, "Thank you" for the cool clouds in a beautiful blue sky, a delicious lunch at school, or finding out that they have no homework.

The children follow the Living Through The Bible schedule. After a time of worship through music, they study a portion of the same scripture that is discussed in the Sunday service. This has been designed by Rev. Moon so that we, as a church family, can all be reading the same passage of the Bible on Sunday.

This can be a challenge at times for young children but, by God's grace, the children are learning to read, discuss and apply a relevant message for them directly from the Bible. God's love and mercy are all over the scriptures even in some of the more difficult passages of the Old Testament. After the lesson, the children work on a craft based on that lesson to reinforce what they have learned.

Our children are our future and our greatest blessing. What a joy they are! Please pray for them. 
