God is good all the time. All the time, God is good. On the evening of September 22, 2021, I received a call from a congregant. She said that her husband was very sick, and she asked me to come and pray for him during his last moments on earth. I immediately got myself ready, picked up my Bible and a hymnal, and went to the hospital.

When I arrived at his room, I saw the sad and tired faces of his family. The man could not speak or even open his eyes. His wife told me that the doctor said that he only had a few hours or maybe a day remaining. It was a very difficult time for the family. I opened the hymnal and started to sing a hymn. "Alas! And did my Savior bleed, And did my Sov-'reign die? Would He devote that sacred head for such a worm as I? At the Cross, at the Cross, where I first saw the light, And the burden of my heart rolled away, It was there by faith I received my sight, And now I am happy all the day!" When I sang that hymn, he slowly opened his eyes and started to nod his head, following the rhythm. His wife and son brightly smiled and raised their voices to praise God. I started to preach on Romans chapter 8 verses 16–18, "It is that very Spirit bearing witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint-heirs with Christ—if, in fact, we suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him. I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory about to be revealed to us."

After he heard the sermon, I asked him a question. "Do you believe that Jesus is your only savior?" He replied, "Amen." The sound that came from his mouth was weak, but it clearly affirmed his faith in Jesus and the promise of salvation. His wife and son said that even if God called him at that time, they would be happy to send him to God's nation. We all praised God.

The next day I came back, and an amazing thing happened. He began to recover. The doctor had stated that he would only live a maximum of three days, but he suddenly began to eat and started to regain his health. After the doctor saw what happened, he was amazed. The doctor allowed the man to leave the hospital and move to a nursing home. His daughter told me that since he was able to walk and eat by himself, he will be able to return home in just a few months. "Hallelujah!"

Remember that life is in God's hand. God can call us anytime. No matter when God calls us, we need to know that we are all in His love. Every morning, I pray for all our members to live in God's grace and mercy. Jesus, our God, promised us, "And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Matthew 28:20) How could Jesus say that? Because God already prepared an eternal nation for us. The most precious name is Jesus, our Savior. Our hope is in heaven. Don't be disappointed in your life. Don't be afraid. God will always be with you. God wants to bless you. Pray to God. God will answer you in God's way. God will be with you now and forever. Amen.
