In the beginning, God created the whole world. He created the land, the seas, the sky, the trees with the fruit that came from them, the animals of the land and the birds of the air. When all this was in place, God created man.

The first humans on earth were Adam and Eve. Eve gave birth to her first son and named him Cain. She then bore a second son and named him Abel.

Cain became a farmer, and Abel was a keeper of sheep. One day, Cain brought God an offering of the fruit of the ground, and Abel brought the firstlings of his flock. God was pleased with Abel's offering, but He was not pleased with Cain's. God understood the heart of the giver. At that moment, Cain was angry. Its desire is for you, but you must master it." (Genesis 4:6-7, NRSV)

God knows everything. We think our desire gives us the winner's crown, but the result is becoming a fugitive and a wanderer on the earth. The result of sin is death. We need to know that "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 6:23, NRSV)

Sin was the reason Cain became a murderer. After this happened, there was nothing he could do to change it. Now, he had to face the consequences. People would kill him as he had done. Cain said to God, "My punishment is greater than I can bear." God responded to this by puttinga mark on Cain so that no one who came upon him would kill him. Even though Cain sinned and murdered his brother, God gave him a chance to live with God's protection when he asked for God's grace. In this we can see God's love.

"Since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; they are now justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a sacrifice of atonement by his blood, effective through faith. He did this to show his righteousness because in his divine forbearance he had passed over the sins previously committed; it was to prove at the present time that he himself is righteous and that he justifies the one who has faith in Jesus." (Romans 3:23-26, NRSV)

Cain kept his life in God's grace even though he was a sinner. God's grace not only keeps our physical life but also gives us eternal life. God sent us his only Son, Jesus. Jesus had no sin, but he died on the cross for us. Jesus paid the price for our sins by His death on the cross. He was resurrected and became the Savior for all people who believe in His name. It is God's perfect grace and love. When you pray with God's Word, God will give His perfect grace to you.
