### **Song of Trust in God Alone**

*To the leader: according to Jeduthun. A Psalm of David.*

- <sup>1</sup> For God alone my soul waits in silence;  
from him comes my salvation.
- <sup>2</sup> He alone is my rock and my salvation,  
my fortress; I shall never be shaken.
- <sup>3</sup> How long will you assail a person,  
will you batter your victim, all of you,  
as you would a leaning wall, a tottering fence?
- <sup>4</sup> Their only plan is to bring down a person of prominence.  
They take pleasure in falsehood;  
they bless with their mouths,  
but inwardly they curse. *Selah*
- <sup>5</sup> For God alone my soul waits in silence,  
for my hope is from him.
- <sup>6</sup> He alone is my rock and my salvation,  
my fortress; I shall not be shaken.
- <sup>7</sup> On God rests my deliverance and my honor;  
my mighty rock, my refuge is in God.
- <sup>8</sup> Trust in him at all times, O people;  
pour out your heart before him;  
God is a refuge for us. *Selah*
- <sup>9</sup> Those of low estate are but a breath;  
those of high estate are a delusion;

in the balances they go up;  
they are together lighter than a breath.

<sup>10</sup> Put no confidence in extortion,  
and set no vain hopes on robbery;  
if riches increase, do not set your heart on them.

<sup>11</sup> Once God has spoken;  
twice have I heard this:

that power belongs to God,

<sup>12</sup> and steadfast love belongs to you, O Lord.

For you repay to all  
according to their work.
