"Look at my hands and my feet; see that it is I myself. Touch me and see; for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." (Luke 24:39)

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ Jesus,

We are now in the middle of the Lenten season. As we approach Jesus' passion, it reminds us of the wounded hands and feet of Jesus Christ marked by nails. Jesus' hands and feet had become ugly and rough from being marked by nails. Although Jesus' hands and feet had become ugly and rough, every place that Jesus' hands and feet touch begins a new life. Jesus' rough hands remind us of "The Praying Hands" by Albrecht Durer.

Looking at "The Praying Hands," each finger of the rough folded hands is very stiff. "The Praying Hands" has a story. Albrecht Durer who painted this picture was so poor that he could not study painting. However, he left home to look for a famous artist. Although he met a good artist and studied, he could not support himself. He met another poor boy who seeked the famous artist. The two boys discussed how to make money for their living expenses with each other. They had an agreement with each other as follows: while one studies, the other works and provides living expenses until one finishes his study. Albrecht Durer was the first one to study. Albrecht Durer studied very hard, and his paintings began to be sold. Now, it was Albrecht Durer's turn to support his friend. Unfortunately, it was impossible for Durer's friend to study painting. Because he had worked very hard for Albrecht, his fingers became stiff. One evening, Albrecht stopped by the place where his friend was living. When Albrecht stood before the door, he could hear the prayer of his friend and see his rough folded hands. When Albrecht saw this, an inspiration arose in his heart. According to his inspiration, he painted "The Praying" Hands." "The Praying Hands" is the symbol of sacrifice for himself to help others. Jesus' rough hands are also the sacrificial hands for the salvation of all people.



B.B. Mckinney composed a hymn "Have You Failed in Your Plan?"- Place your hand in the nail-scarred hand, place yours in the nail-scarred hand; He will keep to the end, He's your dearest Friend. Place your hand in the nailed-scarred hand." Let us hold Jesus' nail-scarred hands. We will receive a new life when we hold Jesus' rough hands.

Jesus says, "Look at my hands and my feet." Jesus wants his disciples to do his work on behalf of his hands and his feet. Jesus asks each one of us, "My friend, can you be my hands and my feet for the ministry of God?" Let us be Jesus' hands and feet on behalf of Christ Jesus.




Come join us to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. Easter marks Jesus' resurrection, three days after his death by crucifixtion.
