"I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in Me(Jesus), even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in Me(Jesus) will never die. Do you believe this?" (John 11:25-26)

Dear sisters and brothers in the Risen Christ Jesus,

As we get closer towards Easter, it reminds us of Jesus' saying, "I am The(my emphasis) Resurrection." What resurrection do we believe? When we talk about resurrection, we think of natural changes, like a seed transforming into a plant, or a caterpillar morphing to a butterfly. As new buds bring forth after they stand all winter, we are filled with admiration for the greatness of life. However, we do not call that resurrection. Sometimes, we compare a cocoon to the Resurrection. A cocoon becomes a butterfly. The butterfly becomes a cocoon again. We do not think of such changes of nature as resurrection. Some may think about immortality; as our bodies die, our souls live forever. We do not think that only our souls live eternally. As Christians, we believe in the resurrection of our bodies. too.



Looking at the Bible, there appear those who were alive again after their deaths. It is not our hope about resurrection that we died and are alive again for the time being. It is our faith to believe in Jesus' Resurrection as the true Resurrection. To me, the Resurrection of Jesus Christ is essential to our faith. We will have the Resurrection of Jesus Christ like the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ became the first fruit of the Resurrection. The Risen Christ Jesus says, 'I am your Resurrection and your eternal life." "Do we believe this?" Christ is risen. He is risen indeed!

Stewardship

What is a Steward? Why do we Give?

Luke 16:1-13, NIV A Reflection During the Lenten Season Sung-ok Lee, Finance Chair

To belong to a church congregation is to be a steward. Some may say that "stewardship" is just a polite way of referring to financial giving to the church. But it's far more than that.

Jesus speaks in many parables. One character in Jesus's parables is the STEWARD — the servant charged by the master to care for the master's property. The master owns the land and the steward is responsible for taking care and tilling the soil, sowing seeds and growing fruits from the seeds.

Jesus says we have three (3) responsibilities and joys as God's STEWARDS:

- 1. Receiving: We receive with joyful thanksgiving the many gifts that God showers upon us time, talent, treasure, our friendships, natural resources, and the beauty around us.
- 2. Managing: We take good care of what we have received. We manage these resources wisely for our own good and the good of others.
 - 3. Giving: Out of our gratitude in receiving so abundantly, we want to share with others.

We may think that our financial resources are our own. But we are the Stewards; God is the owner. So what we earn, how we earn it, how we save, spend, and give it away, are all matters of Christian stewardship.

One aspect of stewardship is our GIVING to God's mission in the world through the church. We've learned that giving is most effective when we commit ourselves to give a definite proportion of our income through the church. For many, this proportion is one-tenth, or a tithe. Whatever the amount, we have discovered the joy in giving to God the "first fruits," an amount "off the top" of our income, not what's left over at the end of the month. May the Holy spirit work in us to be God's good stewards.


