"Honor your father and mother." Which is the first commandment with a promise--"that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth."(Ephesians 6:2-3)



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ Jesus,

The month of May reminds us of Mother's Day. Mother's Day is observed on the second

Sunday in May. Mother's Day honors all mothers. Mother's Day began with a special

service in May 1907 at the Methodist Episcopal Church in Grafton, West Virginia. The

service was organized by a Methodist laywoman, Anna Iarvis to honor her mother who

died on May 9, 1905. By 1908, Anna Jarvis was advocating that all mothers be honored

on the second Sunday in May. In 1912, the Methodist

Episcopal Church recognized the

day and raised it to the national agenda. Thanks to Anna Jarvis, every year, we celebrate Mother's Day on the second Sunday in May.

According to the Bible, the family is God's design. God made Adam to put him in the

Garden of Eden. Adam had everything he wanted. But God said, "It is not good for man to be alone. I will make a companion who will help him" (Genesis 2:18). Whether we are married or single and whether we have children or not, we are made for each other. We are made for relationships. Whether you are married or single, you still need relationships with others in your life. You and I are not made to be alone. So, God created the family.

Exodus 20:12 is about the Ten Commandments. The Ten Commandments has two

parts. The first Five Commandments are about the relationships between God and us.

The second of the Five Commandments are about human relationships. The first

Commandment on the human relationships begins with parents and their children.

Exodus 20: 12 says, "Honor your father and mother.

Then you will live a long, full life in

the land the Lord your God will give you." In the New Testament, Iesus summarized the

Ten Commandments with the two great Commandments. "First, love your God. Second,

love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 22:37-39). Our closest neighbors are our

parents.

What is God's purpose for our parents? God has given our parents to us to bless us.

Ephesians 6:2-3 say, "Honor your father and mother. This is the first of the Ten

Commandments that ends with a promise. And this is the promise: If you honor your

father and mother, you will live a long life, full of blessing." Our parents are here for our

blessings. God uses your father and mother as instruments of blessings for you.

Our two mothers lived with us in the same house. My mother-in-law passed away during
Covid 19, two years ago. Currently, my mother lives with us. My mother-in-law always

prayed for us while she was with us. Now, my mother prays for our family every day. My wife and I believe that God uses our two mothers for our blessings.

As I reflect on my childhood, my mother was always my shelter. Sometimes, I returned, home in my depression and anger, my mother comforted and encouraged me. My mother was my shelter. To me, my home was the place of acceptance.

Today, we see many families shake emotionally, financially, and spiritually, and the place of acceptance becomes the place of rejection. May God make our homes welcoming places! Let us give our thanks to our mothers as we celebrate Mother's Day.

In Memory of Jose Antonio Cintron

November 16th, 1954 - April 22nd, 2023



Jose Antonio Cintron has been a member of the Bayside United Methodist Church for 27 years. Up until his passing, he served as the chair of the board of Trustees and chair of the Staff Pastor Parish Relations Committee.

Born in Puerto Rico, Jose came to the United States with his parents and siblings when he was 4 years old and was one of 9 children. He grew up in the Bronx up until High School. He went on into the military, first in Texas, then Germany and then to Korea, where he met Sun in 1980.

One year later they came together to New York and were married in 1981. They eventually settled in Queens and lived together for 43 years in marriage.

Jose has had a career in restaurant management, a family business in Manhattan, for 35 years. He continued to work in the food industry for another four years, until he developed cancer in 2016. He underwent surgery in 2017 and thankfully went into remission. Sadly the cancer returned in early 2023. He received chemo treatment for several weeks, but with a worsened condition, he was hospitalized at North Shore hospital for six weeks. He was transferred to Memorial Sloan Kettering in Manhattan and stayed for one week until he passed peacefully on Saturday, April 22, with his loving wife Sun by his bedside. He is preceded in death by his father seven years ago and his mother five years ago. He has siblings living in Westchester County, New York; Virginia; and Florida.

Jose's legacy at Bayside UMC will be revered and long celebrated. He played a critical leadership role when the church was in a most vulnerable state during the COVID-19 years. He has brought his property management skills as well as his unwavering faithfulness in stewardship and trust to fulfill God's mission at Bayside UMC. The congregation is deeply saddened by the loss of this brother and leader. As he joins the cloud of witnesses that have gone on to glory from this beloved church, may Christ's love and peace surround his wife and family at this time.

Mother's Day, May 14th, 2023


Mother's Day is an important date as it celebrates mothers all throughout the world. This day is to commemorate and celebrate the mothers of our families and to thank them for everything they do for us.


