Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ Jesus, Father's Day is observed on the third Sunday of every June. This day honors all fathers. It was first celebrated in Spokane, Washington, in 1910. Father's Day was inspired by a woman named Sonora Smart Dodd. When she heard a Mother's Day sermon in 1909, Sonora was inspired to celebrate a day to honor all fathers too. Her own father, Civil War veteran William Jackson Smart (1842-1919), was a single parent who raised her and her 5 siblings after the death of his wife. Since then, we have kept Father's Day on the third Sunday of June. As we celebrate Father's Day, the Gospel of Luke chapter 15 reminds us of a story about a troubled and problematic family. The story begins with a younger son and his father. We call the story "The Prodigal Son." One day, the younger son said to his father, "Father, give me my share of the property now." So the father divided his property between his two sons. After a few days, the younger son sold his part of the property and left home with the money. The younger one went to a country far away. He wasted his money on reckless living. Finally, he came to his senses and said, "I have sinned against God and my father." So he started his journey back to his father. When the younger son returned home, he returned as a beggar. But his father had been waiting for his younger son. The father received his younger son with joy. The father dressed the younger son in the best robe and placed a ring on his finger and shoes on his feet. A party began.



This story talks about a relationship between a father and his sons, and a relationship between two siblings. The two brothers appeared to have a competitive relationship rather than a cooperative relationship.



The names of the students are as follows: Jackson Murray, Makaya & Makayla Maynard, Imani Jolie Fridie, Daniel Han, Faith Han, Sam Han, Sunday, June 11th, we celebrate graduation Sunday. This year, Sam Han and Annette Murray are graduating from high school and going off to college. I pray that God's great blessings be with both of them. We, Bayside United Methodist Church, must continue to be used in this community for the sake of the gospel. 
