## Romans 10:5-15 New Revised Standard Version Updated Edition

## **Salvation Is for All**

<sup>5</sup> Moses writes concerning the righteousness that comes from the law, that "the person who does these things will live by them." <sup>6</sup> But the righteousness that comes from faith says, "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?' " (that is, to bring Christ down) <sup>7</sup> "or 'Who will descend into the abyss?' " (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). <sup>8</sup> But what does it say?

"The word is near you,

in your mouth and in your heart"

(that is, the word of faith that we proclaim), <sup>9</sup> because<sup>III</sup> if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe<sup>III</sup> in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For one believes<sup>III</sup> with the heart, leading to righteousness, and one confesses with the mouth, leading to salvation. <sup>11</sup> The scripture says, "No one who believes<sup>III</sup> in him will be put to shame." <sup>12</sup> For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; the same Lord is Lord of all and is generous to all who call on him. <sup>13</sup> For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

<sup>14</sup> But how are they to call on one in whom they have not believed?<sup>[]</sup> And how are they to believe<sup>[]</sup> in one of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone to proclaim him? <sup>15</sup> And how are they to proclaim him unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"
