Sickness Policy

If your child is experiencing any of the following symptoms please keep them home from camp. We reserve the right to temporarily deny any child admittance to our camp if they are sick or present with any contagious illnesses. If your child starts presenting symptoms during camp hours, a parent or approved guardian must be able to pick up your child.

- Fever over 100 degrees
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Persistent coughing
- Rash
- Lice
- Pink eye
- Eye Discharge

Dropoff and Pickup

- If your child is running late to camp, or is being dropped off at a later time than arrival, please give us a call and let us know.
- If your child is getting picked up at a different time than their dismissal, you MUST call and notify us.
- If your child is getting picked up by someone other than their parent or guardian, you MUST call and notify us.
- Please note that parents and guardians are NOT permitted to pick up their child before dismissal time unless
 we are notified beforehand.

Admission Requirements

Please note these requirements are MANDATORY

- Completed Registration forms
- Completed Medical documents reviewed by child's doctor
- · Vaccine and Immunization Records
- · Emergency blue card

Behavior Policy

All students and children must act accordingly.
Unacceptable behavior such as bullying, teasing,
hitting, fighting, biting, and etc will not be tolerated.

- All students and children receive three verbal warnings a day before any action is taken.
- If a student continues unacceptable behavior, we will pull them aside to have a one on one conversation.
- If a student still is engaging in unacceptable behavior, we will put them in a short time out zone.
- If all methods have been utilized and the child still does not listen, a phone call home will be made to discuss with parents.
