(Luke 24:39)

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ Jesus, The Lenten season is arriving, beginning on Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024, and ending on March 30, Holy Saturday. Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays (every Sunday is always a little Easter.) The season of Lent, historically, is known as a period of fasting and of repenting by all Christians. The Gospel of Luke 24:39 says, "Look at my hands and my feet; see that it is I myself. Touch me and see, for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." I think of Jesus' hands and feet on the cross when I read this passage. Jesus' hands and feet were marked by nails resulting in them, being ugly and rough. Although Jesus' hands and feet are ugly and rough, every place where Jesus' hands and feet touch begins a new life. Jesus' rough hands remind me of "The Praying Hands" by Albrecht Durer. Looking at "The Praying Hands," each finger of the rough folded hands is very stiff. Although there are many kinds of fictional stories, "The Praying Hands" is special because it grants us inspiration. "The Praying Hands" is the ultimate symbol of sacrifice for others. Jesus' nail-marked hands are the sacrificial hands for the salvation of all people. B.B. Mckinney composed a hymn called "Have You Failed in Your Plans?"- Place your hand in the nail-scarred hand, place your hand in the nail-scarred hand; He will keep to the end, He's your dearest Friend, Place your hand in the nail-scarred hand." Sisters and brothers, let us hold Jesus' rough hands. We will receive a new life when we hold Jesus' rough hands.



Jesus also says, "Look at my hands and my feet." Jesus wanted his disciples to do his work on behalf of his hands and his feet. Likewise, Jesus asks each one of us, "My friend, can you be my hands and my feet for the ministry of God?" Let us be Jesus' hands and feet on behalf of Christ Jesus.

Stewards for God's Ministry in 2024





Luke 16:1-13, NRSV

A Reflection for the Lenten Season

To belong to a church congregation is to be a steward. Some may say that "stewardship" is just a polite way of referring to financial giving to the church. But it's far more than that. Jesus speaks in many parables. One character in Jesus's parables is the STEWARD — the servant charged by the master to care for the master's property. The master owns the land and the steward is responsible for taking care and tilling the soil, sowing seeds and growing fruits from the seeds. Jesus teaches us we have three (3) responsibilities and joys as God's STEWARDS:

- 1. Receiving: We receive with joyful thanksgiving the many gifts that God showers upon us time, talent, treasure, our friendships, natural resources, and the beauty around us.
- 2. Managing: We take good care of what we have received. We manage these resources wisely for our own good and the good of others.
- 3. Giving: Out of our gratitude in receiving so abundantly, we are to share with others.

We may think that our financial resources are our own. But we are the Stewards; God is the owner. So what we earn, how we earn it, how we save, spend, and give away, are all matters of Christian stewardship. One aspect of stewardship is our GIVING to God's mission in the world through the church. We've learned that giving is most effective when we commit ourselves to give a definite proportion of our income through the church. For many, this proportion is one-tenth, or a tithe. Whatever the amount, we have discovered the joy in giving to God the "first fruits," an amount "off the top" of our income, not what's left over at the end of the month. Once again in 2024, may the Holy spirit work in us to be God's good stewards.
