"Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you."

(John 20:21)

Dear sisters and brothers in the Risen Christ Jesus, On March 31, we celebrated an Easter service with all congregations (English, Korean, and Modern Multi-Worship) in a combined service. We are now in the latter part of the post-Easter season.

When the risen Christ appeared to his disciples, he said to them, "As the Father has sent me, so I am sending you." What does this statement of the risen Christ Jesus mean? "As the Father has sent me, so I am sending you." It means that the risen Christ Jesus gave an assignment to his disciples. That assignment was their life mission. The moment you and I chose to become a Christian, is the moment we gave our lives to Jesus Christ. God has an assignment for you and me. That is called mission.

Although each one of us has a different mission on earth, God has given us all the same assignment in common. That is, God wants you and I to tell other people about what's happened to us because of Jesus Christ. God wants us to share our testimony, our lifestyle, our witness, and the good news.

Saint Paul in Acts 20: 24 says about his mission "Life is worth nothing unless I use it for doing the work assigned me by the Lord Jesus- the work of telling others the Good News about God's mighty kindness and love." Once you and I accept Jesus Christ as our Savior and Lord, our Boss and C.E.O in life, one of our life missions is that you and I invite people into God's family. Part of my life mission is to invite other people into God's Church.



Romans 1:17 says, "This Good News tells us that
God makes us ready for heavenmakes us right in God's sight- when we put our faith
and trust in Christ to save us. This
is accomplished from start to finish by faith."
Trusting Jesus Christ is good news. When
you trust Jesus Christ, don't have a doubtful mind.
Your doubtful mind means that you
don't truly trust Jesus Christ. James says about a
doubtful mind like this. "A doubtful
mind is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is driven
and tossed by the wind. They
cannot make up their minds." (James 1:6). Do we
expect good news? Let us trust Jesus
Christ in our unshakable faith.

Let us invite our friends into God's family. Let us tell
them the Good News. This is
the mission in common you and I have from the risen
Jesus Christ. Let us listen to the
risen Christ Jesus once more. "As the Father has sent
me, I am sending you." (John
20:21).

부활하신 우리 주 예수 그리스도의 이름으로 문안 드립니다.

이번 3월31일 부활 주일에 우리 베이사이드연합감리교회 전체 회중들(영어회중, 한어회중과 모던멀타이예배 회중)이 연합예배를 드렸습니다. 이제 우리는 부활절 이후를 살아가고 있습니다.

### Stewards for God's Ministry in 2024

A Reflection for the Lenten Season

To belong to a church congregation is to be a steward. Some may say that "stewardship" is just a polite way of referring to financial giving to the church. But it's far more than that. Jesus speaks in many parables. One character in Jesus's parables is the STEWARD — the servant charged by the master to care for the master's property. The master owns the land and the steward is responsible for taking care and tilling the soil, sowing seeds and growing fruits from the seeds. Jesus teaches us we have three (3) responsibilities and joys as God's STEWARDS:

- 1. Receiving: We receive with joyful thanksgiving the many gifts that God showers upon us time, talent, treasure, our friendships, natural resources, and the beauty around us.
- 2. Managing: We take good care of what we have received. We manage these resources wisely for our own good and the good of others.
- 3. Giving: Out of our gratitude in receiving so abundantly, we are to share with others.

We may think that our financial resources are our own. But we are the Stewards; God is the owner. So what we earn, how we earn it, how we save, spend, and give away, are all matters of Christian stewardship. One aspect of stewardship is our GIVING to God's mission in the world through the church. We've learned that giving is most effective when we commit ourselves to give a definite proportion of our income through the church. For many, this proportion is one-tenth, or a tithe. Whatever the amount, we have discovered the joy in giving to God the "first fruits," an amount "off the top" of our income, not what's left over at the end of the month. Once again in 2024, may the Holy spirit work in us to be God's good stewards.

If you are interested in volunteerism as well as receiving a PVCA, please come to the church office to receive more information.






