

## Hebrews 2:6-10

<sup>6</sup> But someone has testified somewhere,  
“What are humans that you are mindful of them<sup>[a]</sup>  
or mortals that you care for them?<sup>[b]</sup>

<sup>7</sup> You have made them for a little while lower<sup>[c]</sup> than the angels;  
you have crowned them with glory and honor,<sup>[d]</sup>

<sup>8</sup> subjecting all things under their feet.”

Now in subjecting all things to them, God<sup>[e]</sup> left nothing outside their control. As it is, we do not yet see everything in subjection to them, <sup>9</sup> but we do see Jesus, who for a little while was made lower<sup>[f]</sup> than the angels, now crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God<sup>[g]</sup> he might taste death for everyone.

<sup>10</sup> It was fitting that God,<sup>[h]</sup> for whom and through whom all things exist, in bringing many children to glory, should make the pioneer of their salvation perfect through sufferings.
