### June Newsletter

"Then the father said to his slaves, 'Quickly, bring out a robe—the best one—and put it on him; put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. And get the fatted calf and kill it, and let us eat and celebrate; for this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found!' And they began to celebrate." (Luke 15:22-24)

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

As we celebrate Father's Day this June, I would like to reflect on the love and grace of God the Father through the words of Luke 15:22-24, and take some time to consider our relationships with our earthly fathers. In this passage, the father in the parable of the prodigal son welcomes his returning son by dressing him in the best robe, placing a ring on his finger, putting sandals on his feet, and preparing a feast with the fatted calf. The gifts the father bestows upon his son are not just decorations; they carry profound spiritual meanings.

The "best robe" signifies a new identity and restoration. The son had wandered far away, burdened by sin and suffering, but the father warmly welcomes him back and dresses him in the finest robe, acknowledging him once again as his son. When we return to God, He offers us a fresh start, regardless of our past. Likewise, in our relationships with our earthly fathers, they should help establish our identities through love and support, enabling us to rise again.

The "ring" represents the restoration of belonging and authority. When the father places a ring on his son's finger, it signifies that he is welcomed back as a member of the family. When we return to our God Father, the grace He gives us restores our sense of authority. In our relationships with our earthly fathers, they should encourage us with wisdom and teachings to live independently. A father's encouragement plays a crucial role in helping children find their paths and grow with a sense of responsibility.

The "sandals" symbolize a life of freedom, not servitude. God the Father allows us to live as free individuals, not as slaves. Similarly, an earthly father should protect his children, helping them grow into mature individuals who understand their freedom.

The "fatted calf" is a symbol of celebration and joy. The father prepares a grand feast to celebrate his son's return, illustrating the great joy God experiences in heaven when a sinner repents and returns to Him. In our relationships with our earthly fathers, they should also rejoice in our achievements and happiness, celebrating our successes. The joy of such celebrations deepens family bonds.

The elements of the "best robe," the "ring," the "sandals," and the "fatted calf" reveal that through the love and forgiveness of God the Father, our spiritual lives can be restored, and we also find opportunities for healing in our relationships with our earthly fathers. On this Father's Day, let us return to God the Father to experience His love, while also taking the time to reflect on our relationships with our earthly fathers. I pray this Father's Day in June is a time when we feel God's love and show our thanks and love to our dads. Happy Father's Day! Amen.

"아버지는 종들에게이르되 제일좋은 옷을내어다가 입히고손에 가락지를끼우고 발에신을 신기라그리고 살진송아지를 끌어다가잡으라 우리가먹고 즐기자이 내아들은 죽었다가다시 살아났으며내가 잃었다가다시 얻었노라하니 그들이즐거워하더라" (누가복음 15:22-24)

우리 주예수 그리스도의이름으로 문안드립니다.

6월 아버지의날(Father's Day)을 맞이하여, 누가복음 15:22-24의 말씀을통해 하나님아버지의 사랑과은혜를 묵상하고, 육체적인 아버지와의관계를 되돌아보는시간을 가져보고자합니다.

누가복음 15:22-24절은 탕자의비유에서 아버지는돌아온 아들에게제일 좋은옷을 입히고, 손에 가락지를끼우며, 발에신을 신기고, 그리고 살진송아지를 잡아잔치를 베풀었습니다. 이 구절들에서아버지가 돌아온아들에게 베풀어주신 것들은단순한 장 식물들이아니라, 각각영적인 의미를가지고 있습니다.

"제일 좋은옷"은새로운 정체성과회복을 의미합니다. 아들은 먼나라에서 방황하며죄와 고통의짐을 지고돌아왔습니다. 그러나아버지는 그를반기며 가장좋은 옷을입히고, 그를다시 자신의아들로 인정합니다. 우리가 하나님께돌아올 때, 우리의 과거와 상관없이 새로운시작을 주시는것입니다. 우리가육체적인 아버지와의관계에서도, 아버지는자녀에게 사랑과지지를 통해그들의 정체성을확립시키고, 그들이다시 일어설수 있도록돕는 역할을해야 합니다.

"손에 가락지"는 아들의소속과 권위의회복을 상징합니다. 아버지가 아들에게가락지를 끼우는것은 단순한반지가 아니라, 그를 가족의일원으로 다시받아들인다는 의미입니다. 우리도하나님 아버지께돌아갈 때, 하나님 아버지가우리에게 주시는은혜는 권위를회복하게 됩니다. 육체적인 아버지와의관계에서도 아버지는자녀가 독립적으로살아갈 수있도록 지혜와가르침으로 격려 해주어야 합니다. 아버지의 격려는우리들의 자녀들이자신의 길을찾아가고 책임감있게 성장하는데 중요한역할을 합니다.

"발에 신"신은 노예가아니라, 자유인으로서의삶을 의미합니다. 하나님 아버지는우리를 노예가아니라, 우리를자유인으로 살아가게해 주십니다. 육체적인 아버지또한 자녀에게보호의 역할을하며, 그들이성숙한 자유인으로성장 할수 있도록도와 주어야합니다.

"살진 송아지"는 잔치와기쁨의 상징입니다. 아버지는 아들이돌아온 것을축하하며, 큰잔치를 베풉니다. 이는 하나님아버지 께서 죄인하나가 회개하여돌아올 때, 하늘에서 큰기쁨을 느끼신다는것을 보여줍니다. 육체적인 아버지와의관계에서도 아버지는자녀의 성취와행복을 함께기뻐하며, 그들의성공을 축하하는존재입니다. 잔치의기쁨은 가족간의 유대감을더욱 깊게만들어줍니다.

"제일 좋은 옷" "손에 가락지" "발에 신"과 "살진 송아지"는 하나님아버지의 사랑과용서를 통해우리의 영적삶이 회복될뿐만 아니라, 육체적인 아버지와의관계에서도 회복의기회를 제공합니다. 아버지의 날을맞이하여, 우리는하나님 아버지께돌아가 하나님의사랑을 경험하며, 동시에 우리의육체적인 아버지와의관계도 다시한번 돌아보는시간을 갖을수 있기를기도합니다. 하나님아버지의 사랑을경험하며, 육체적인아버지에게도 감사와 사랑을표현하는 아버지날이 되길주님의 이름으로축복합니다. 아멘.


